Sub: Creation of PPP Cell in Directorate of Urban Land Transport

PREAMBLE:

The Government of Karnataka has taken many initiatives in various sectors for promoting Public - Private Partnership. As a continuation of this initiative, Infrastructure Development Department, Government of Karnataka has appointed consultants for carrying out pre-feasibility studies of selected projects.

In order to ensure that proper follow up of works taken up on Public - Private Partnership model, it is decided to set up a dedicated cell in the Directorate of Urban Land Transport, Urban Development Department, Bangalore under the overall guidance and supervision of the Commissioner, Urban Land Transport.

Hence, this order

1. The Government is pleased to set up a PPP cell within Directorate of Urban Land Transport with the following functions:
 - a. To identify, conceptualize and create a shelf of projects in consultation with the line departments and recommend approval of suitable projects for implementation on PPP route.
 - b. To assist in preparing the pre-feasibility reports through consultants.
 - c. To assist in preparing the Detailed Project Reports.
 - d. To appoint/select consultants to develop the projects in consultation with the concerned organization, if any.
 - e. To help respective organization/office to conduct the bidding process for selection of developers.
 - f. To interact with the Government of India and other funding agencies for obtaining funding /technical expertise.
 - g. To act as the nodal agency for capacity building for PPP in the office conduct/recommend exposure visits and training programmes on PPP.
 - h. To develop internal evaluation guidelines in consultation with stakeholders to evaluate and assess the projects whether the projects are to be funded by the State Government or implemented with Private Sector participation.
 - i. To recommend projects to Government of India for grants under Viability Gap Funding Scheme.
